Asset Management Best Practices

Questions to consider:

- 1. What do I own?
- 2. Where is it located?
- 3. What's the condition?
- 4. What is its expected life?
- 5. What is its value?



Categorize

- → Create asset categories that make the most sense for your organization
- → Make your assets easier to locate, track and maintain
- Know how assets are most commonly used





Assessment

- Log the current condition and life expectancy
- Pull any existing maintenance history
- Determine your asset values
- → Calculate repair and replacement costs



Inventory

→ Create a list of assets you

Include as much information as

number, barcode, warranty

possible: photos, locations, serial

- → Address any existing issues found
- → Utilize work orders to track maintenance and repairs. Include parts, labor hours, costs, etc.



Establish standards

- → Keep track of manuals
- Monitor warranties
- Define maintenance task lists and develop PM schedules
